

60 Second Biography



Instructions

- On your desk is a notecard with a name of a significant person, place or thing from the history of the Pacific Northwest. We may or may not discuss this person at some point in this class, but it is your job to give the class a **brief** biography of the individual. Everyone will share their significant person on Monday. You will be graded on whether you completed the assignment or not. To get full points you only need to make sure to cover all the requirements and present your person! You could start the year off with 100% as your grade! Use a notecard to help you remember all of your information!

Requirements:

- If they are a person: Correct pronunciation their name (include the phonetic spelling if this helps you), years they lived (or are they still alive?) and major life events related to the Pacific Northwest.
- If they are a place or thing: Why is it significant to Northwest history
- No longer than 60 seconds! (Aim for about 45 seconds)
