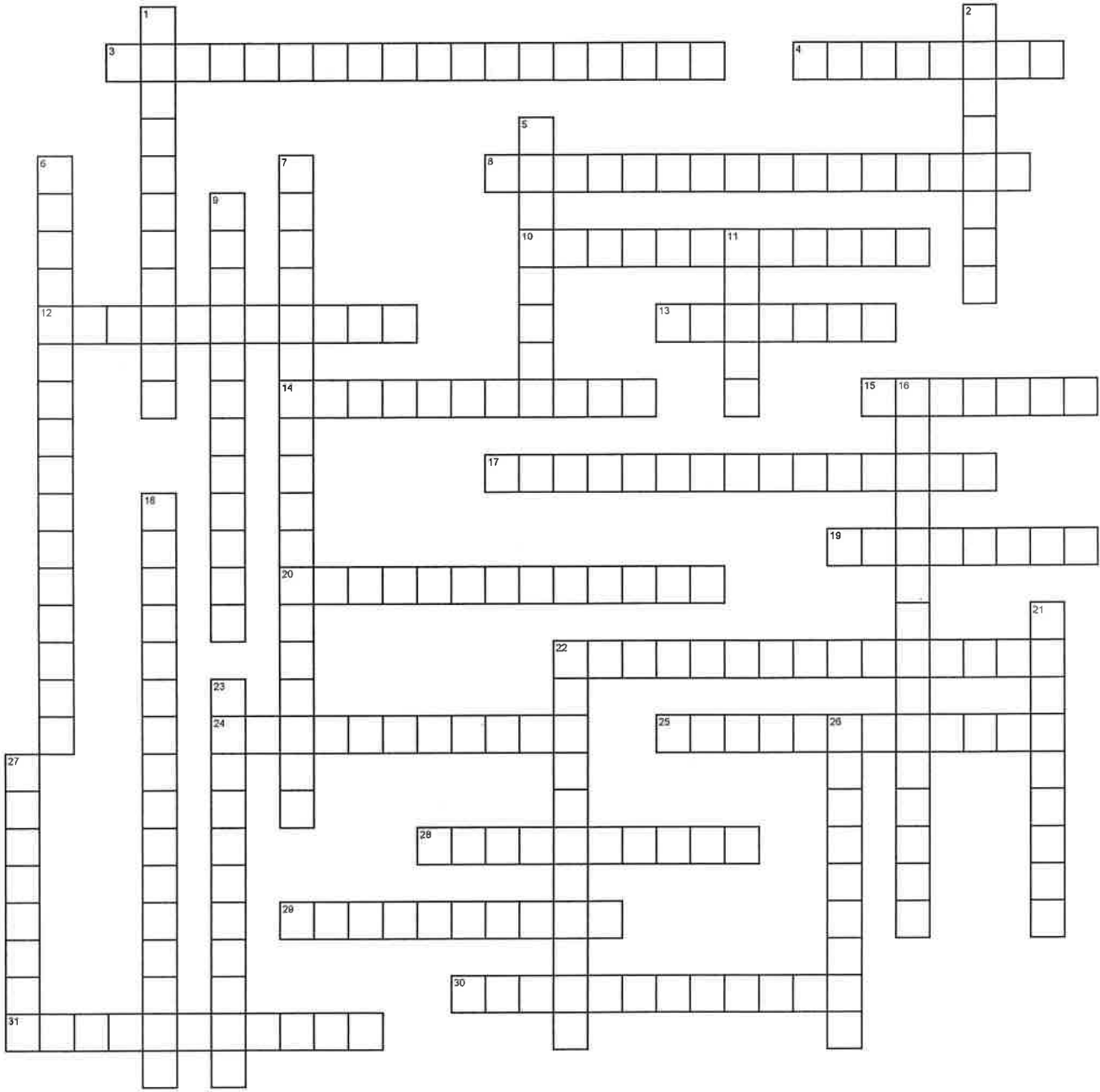


The Age of Absolutism and Revolution

- 3 Believed that both boys and girls should be educated equally (two words)
- 4 The right to vote
- 8 The Third Estate renamed themselves prior to the revolution (2 words)
- 10 Thought people were inherently bad and needed to be governed by a strong monarch (2 words)
- 12 Feeling of pride in one's country
- 13 Montesquieu saw the perfect form of government to exist here
- 14 Became the head of the Committee of Public Safety, eventually becoming a victim himself
- 15 Proved Copernicus' theory of a sun-centered universe correct by tracking Venus
- 17 Wrote the American Declaration of

Independence (two words)

- 19 Believed in the rights of free speech and press, but saw a good and fair king as the most beneficial form of government
- 20 A time following the revolution in which 16,000 people were executed for being traitors (3 words)
- 22 Final battle of Napoleon's reign, marked the end of France's control of Europe (3 words)
- 24 Name given to Napoleon's return to the throne of France (2 words)
- 25 The set of laws used to govern France after the Revolution (two words)
- 28 These were important to the British in providing revenue and ports to replenish supplies (includes numbers)
- 29 This building was seen as the physical manifestation of the dangers of

absolute rule

- 30 He wrote the essay "What is Enlightenment?" (two words)
- 31 Developed the laws of gravity and motion of objects (two words)

- 1 The dominant religion of Europe in the 17th and 18th centuries
- 2 Declared himself Emperor of France in 1804
- 5 This was torn down by hand after all the weapons were removed from it
- 6 Name given to period of history in which people began to use thought and reason to challenge the established order (2 words)
- 7 This idea, championed by Rousseau, stated that people should be able to choose the form of government under

which to live (2 words)

- 9 Along with Rene Descartes, he is considered one of the fathers of the Enlightenment (two words)
- 11 The only successful slave revolt occurred here
- 16 Ruler who has total control over a nation or state (two words)
- 18 Led the Congress of Vienna in order to return Europe into the hands of ruling families
- 21 Believed that all people were born with natural rights (2 words)
- 22 July 14th in France
- 23 Name given to the Enlightenment thinkers; means "lovers of wisdom"
- 26 He applied Enlightenment thought to economics (two words)
- 27 Was overthrown and eventually killed by the French people following the revolution
