The Greeks designed living environments called city-states and every city state was separated by things such as different government forms to make every city state unique.



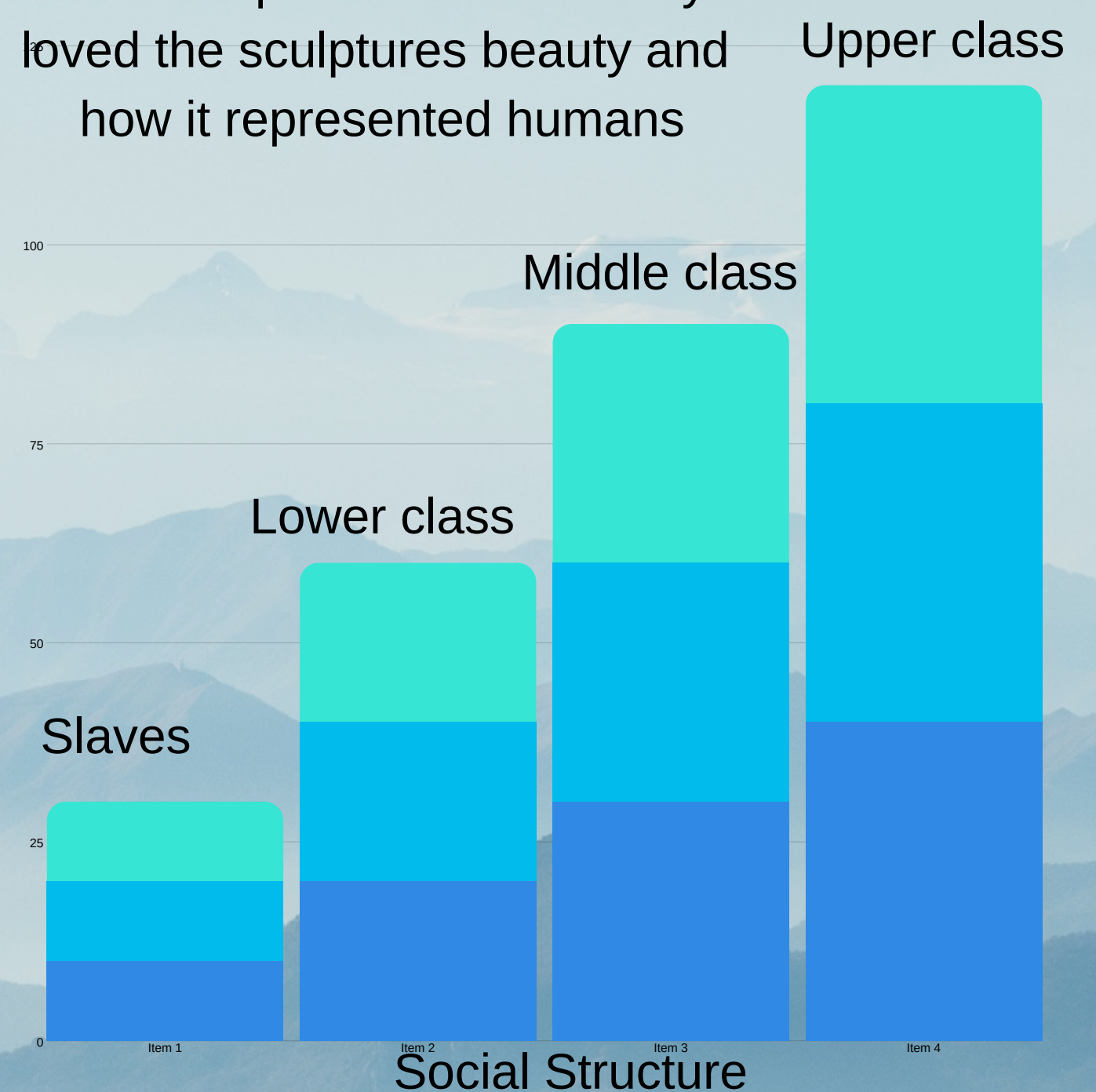
## Art

This represents the social status of all the people. The slaves had the least privelidge, then lower class, middle class, and upper class. Social status of the Greeks influenced later civilizations with their social hierarchy.
