**Part I:** Locate each of the areas described below. Label each of the areas on the map with the name in the book and the corresponding letter (i.e., Wakanda (Q)).

- A. British colony at the southern tip of Africa
- B. French island possession
- C. Independent nation on the west coast
- D. French possession bordering the above nation (letter "C")
- E. Portuguese possessions on the west coast (there are 2)
- F. South-central Belgian possession
- G. Portuguese possession on the east coast
- H. Northernmost British possession
- I. German possession on the east coast
- J. Italian possession on the northern coast
- K. Independent nation in the eastern part of Africa
