

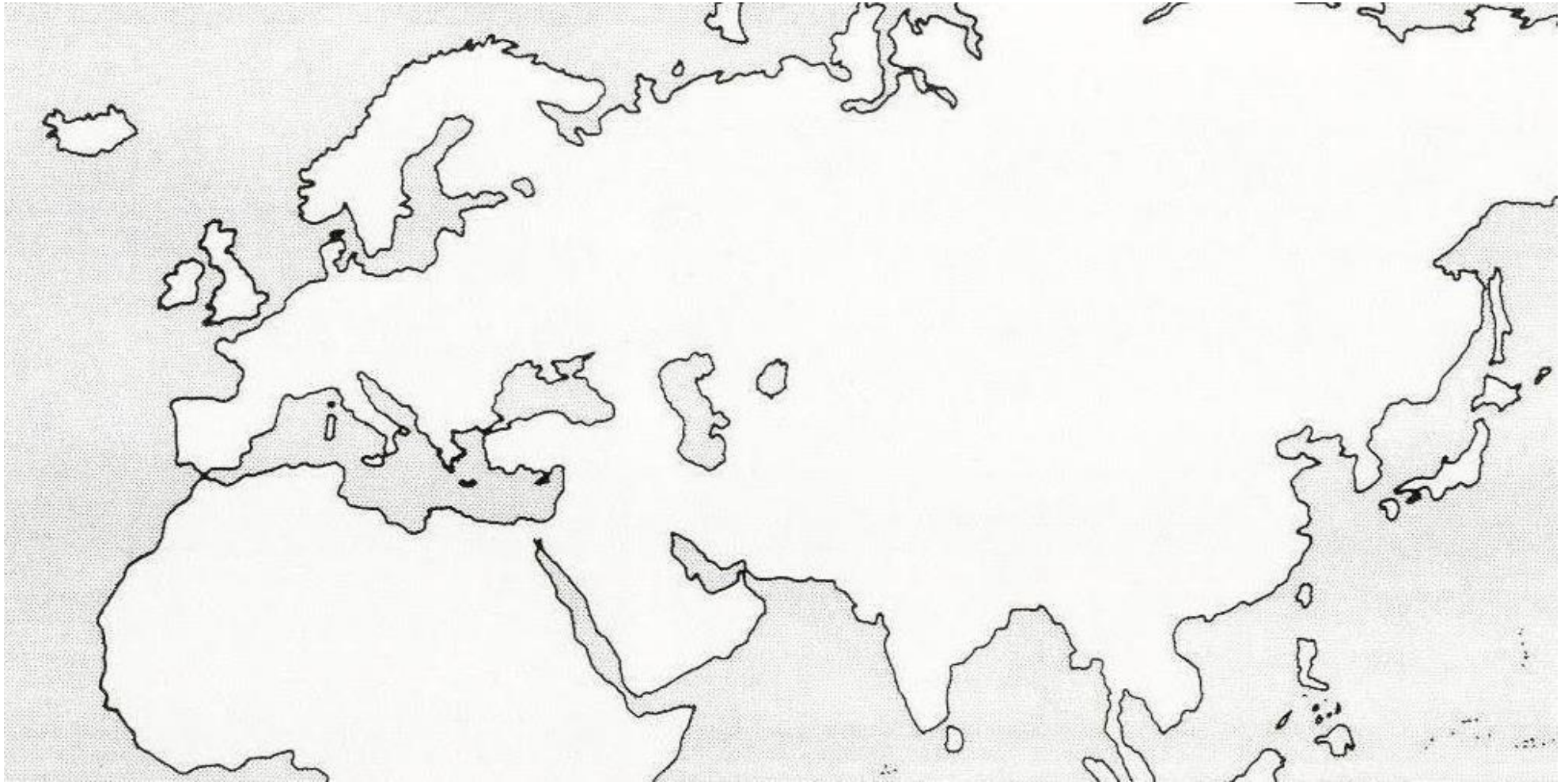
Mapping the Silk Roads
