
Stages of the French Revolution Foldable Instructions

Setting up your foldable:

1) Fold one corner of the paper to the opposite side.





- 2) You will need to cut the bottom rectangle away from the triangle shaped piece. Do not rip the extra piece off, as it might not rip properly!
- 3) Once you have a square paper, fold all four sides into the center.



4) Congratulations, you have completed the set-up of your foldable!


Directions:

1) The outer flaps must be colorful and labeled with the different stages and names of the French Revolution.

Stage One: The Meeting of Estates General


Stage Two: The Storming of the Bastille

Stage Three: Radical Revolution
Stage Four: The Rise of Napoleon



The back of the foldable <u>MUST</u> be labeled with the title: French Revolution, your name and period.

The inner center square <u>MUST</u> have a picture that represents the French Revolution. The picture can be a printed/computer reproduced image or hand-drawn and <u>MUST</u> be in color.



The inner flaps must contain the following information for ALL four stages:

- 1. How did the organization/person come to power?
- 2. Describe the role of the organization/person in the French Revolution. What did it/he do? What purpose did it serve?
- 3. Who were the members of the organization?
- 4. What was the end result?

Take pride in your work, neatness counts.

Stages of the French Revolution Foldable Instructions

Storybook / Foldable Vocabulary (bold words must be used in description)

Stage #1 – The Meeting of the Estates General
Financial crisis; Third Estate; Louis XVI; taxes; Pledge; National Assembly

Stage #2 – The Storming of the Bastille
July 14, 1789; prison; gunpowder; revolution

Stage #3 – The Radical Revolution
Robespierre; guillotine; treason; republic

Stage #4 – The Rise of Napoleon
First Consul, Emperor; military success; glory; exile

*Each of the bolded words MUST be used in your description of the event taking place.

Example: Louis XVI imposed harsh taxes on the Third Estate.
