### Cards (NO PENCIL on final product!!!):

Front: Can be computer generated or hand-written:

- ✓ Name in fairly large letters
- ✓ Picture of the individual
- ✓ Decorate to reflect the ideas of the person

Back: Divided into 3 sections (must have two (2) items in each section and be hand-written):

- ✓ Major Achievements/Philosophy/Ideas
- ✓ Quotes (must be relevant to Achievements/Philosophy/Ideas you noted)
- ✓ Important works they published
- ✓ Your name

#### Extra Information:

Each group member must produce 3 cards.

Groups can divide up the Philosophers/Scientists as they with.

Only groups of 3 or 4 are acceptable.


Groups of 3 will produce a total of 9 cards, groups of 4 will produce 12 cards.
