Task: Create a visual representation of the Pacific Northwest, highlighting critical landmarks for context and reference.

- 1) Include a legend (for generic shapes) and label all required locations
- 2) Draw the actual shape/appearance of the political borders (i.e. state borders)
- 3) Add color for physical features (blue for rivers, oceans, etc.)
- 4) Include a city you have lived in within the Pacific Northwest (hint: Issaquah)
- 5) Add a compass for direction
- 6) No use of computer generated images
- 7) Make it detailed and professional
