Since you can't use a phone or an atlas on the test, memorization is required. You are responsible for knowing where the approximately 188 countries listed below are located. The test will consist of 100 locations. You will need to decide what country is at the location and write it on the answer sheet. It is okay if you don't spell it perfectly, but I have to be able to tell that what you tried to spell is that country and not another one. You will have three chances to take the test. I will keep the highest score. The map tests will be on: Oct 1/2 during the last half of class, Oct. 31, and Nov 12/13 during last half of class. There are plenty of resources out there to help you prepare. The maps used for the test come from either the Arizona Geographic Alliance or the Brigham Young University Geography Department both of which share those maps online.
