- 1) YouTube – As you are probably already aware, this is a great resource to have others present information to you. Videos/Lectures to watch:

- 3) Create bubble maps with a large topic in the center and examples in outer bubbles
- 4) Draw Unit Onepager visuals to synthesize content
- 5) Quizlet - Ms. Smith's vocabulary page and other's created ones
- 6) Review documents and other materials provided by myself or Ms. Smith
- 7) Visit Fiveable (fiveable.me) and watch some of the unit review webinars
- 8) AP HuG review book – do the unit quizzes and comprehensive quizzes ***If you go this route, get the newest version for updated FRQ examples***
