Key Economic Facts on Washington Agriculture

- 35,000 Farms; 95% family owned
- 300 commodities grown
- \$49 billion overall value of food and agriculture industry
- \$10.6 billion market value of crops and livestock
- 13% of Washington's economy
- 160,000 employed in agriculture and food industry
- Ranks No.1 in U.S. production of 10 commodities
- \$15.1 billion in food and agriculture products exported through Washington ports in 2013, third largest total in U.S.
