CRITERIA FOR SWAY PRESENTATION (40 points)

- I) <u>Content:</u> Accurate information? Shows depth of understanding? Acknowledges **significant turning points** of belief system? Is the content historical and objective? (25 points)
- 2) <u>Visuals:</u> Deliberate and thoughtful choices of visuals? Reflective of key shifts in belief system? (15 points)
- 3) <u>Organization and Layout:</u> Logical and thoughtful progression? Neat and readable? Are there spelling mistakes? (5 points)
- 4) Research: Reveals solid research? **Proper bibliography** included? (5 points)

PRESENTATION (20 points)

- I) Do you use of all of the qualities of a good verbal presentation (i.e.: articulate words, good pacing, eye contact with audience, etc.)
- 2) Do you use your slide show in an effective manner to convey the proper information during the presentation?
- 3) Are you able to answer questions and clarify for the class if they do not understand?
- 4) Do you read the presentation to the class or are you active and engaged?

VISUAL (15 points)

- 1) Are the major beliefs of the belief system clearly depicted?
- 2) Are images and icons of historical relevance and are they accurately displayed?
- 3) Is the visual neat and orderly?

World Belief Systems Project









Our first major project of the year will be a combination of technology (you will be using Microsoft Sway), and in-depth research to look at analyze the development of a particular world belief system. Once you have completed your research, you will then create a presentation using Microsoft Sway that shows the basic tenets and practices, as well as how the belief system has **changed over time.** You are NOT simply giving a presentation on the history of the belief system. 3 key turning points, or shifts in practice/ideology, must be included in presentation and discussed.

When assessing the major shifts of global belief systems, you will want to ask yourself a few key questions as a guideline:

- ❖ How was the belief system originally practiced? What were some of the key beliefs that can be traced to original scriptures or texts at inception?
- ❖ What are some key decisions made by the followers/leaders of the religion that may have changed the original intent and practices of the founder?
- ❖ What were the causes and consequences as the belief system spread form one place to another?
- ❖ How does the belief system stand now? If the original founder of the religion were to evaluate how the religion is practiced today, would they recognize it?

REQUIREMENTS:

- Presentation must reflect a clear understanding of the belief systems' basic beliefs and practices.
- Presentation must reflect key snapshots i.e.: the origin, the major/key turning points (3 are required), major conflicts and present day situation.
- Presentation should include visuals that reflect changes to belief system. Consider including art, primary leaders, architecture, etc.

❖ Presentation should be 7 - 10 minutes long - it cannot be shorter or longer!!
